 Parent & School Symptom Screening Tool
 2021-2022 School Year

Please complete daily prior to school.

Please post this in your home and use it to help us pre-screen your child before sending him or her to school every day.

1. Is the student taking any medication to treat or reduce a fever such as Ibuprofen (i.e. Advil, Motrin) or Acetaminophen (Tylenol)?
2. IF UNVACCINATED for COVID-19, has the student been in contact with anyone known to have or suspected to have COVID-19 in the last 14 days?
3. Is the student experiencing any of the following?

Group A 1 or more symptoms	Group B 2 or more symptoms
Fever (100.0 or higher)	Sore throat
New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing (for students with chronic allergic/asthmatic cough, a change in their cough from baseline; example: worsening cough, cough not improved with inhaler medication, productive cough etc.)	Runny nose/congestion
Shortness of breath	Chills
Difficulty breathing	Fatigue
New lack of smell or taste	Muscle pain
	Nausea or Vomiting
	Headache
	Diarrhea

Please keep the student at home/send the student home if he or she*:

- Has one or more symptoms in Group A **OR**
 - Has two or more symptoms in Group B **OR**
 - Is taking fever reducing medication **OR**
 - Has been in close contact with a person known or suspected to have COVID-19 (and is **not** fully vaccinated, or **is** fully vaccinated *but is having new symptoms following an exposure*)** “Close contact” is defined as being within 6 feet of a positive case of COVID-19 for a duration of 15 minutes or longer.
- Fully vaccinated individuals who are identified as close contacts to COVID-19 should mask for 14 days after last exposure to the positive individual and testing is recommended on day 3-5 after last exposure.
 - ***If your child is kept home from school with illness per the screening tool above, please contact the school nurse for return to school instructions.**

****Please notify the school nurse of any positive COVID-19 test or exposure.**
