## Roasted Rhubarb – Try this seasonal delight!

Trout in the Classroom is a partnership between the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission (PFBC), the Pennsylvania Council of Trout Unlimited (PATU), Pennsylvania District 7 of the PA Trappers Associations and the Mifflinburg Area School District. This program is in its fifth year.

This year, our students raised 39 Brook Trout from eggs in early November to release on May 7<sup>th</sup>. The release site was Laurel Run behind the West End Fairgrounds. They were about 3 inches long.

In a separate tangible experience (live capture), these students also received a mini-lesson on macroinvertebrates and amphibians.

This is a unit of study in the Biotechnology area of the Invention, Innovation and Product Development Course taught by Mr. Stenger at the High School.

The celebration of National Teacher's Week was last week which sparked some curiosities about teachers and education in general. . .

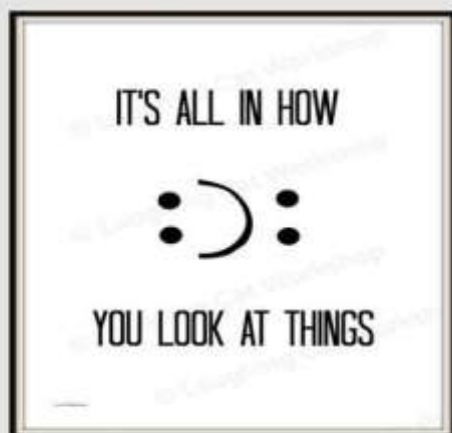
**How many teachers are there currently in the U.S.?** *In America's public schools, there are approximately 3.2 million full-time equivalent teachers.*

**What percentage of teachers are women?** *In this female dominated industry, approximately 76.6% of teachers are female, while only 23.4% are male.*

**How much does the U.S. spend on K-12 education each year?** *In the United States, it is estimated that \$649 Billion is spent on K-12 education annually.*

**How much does it cost to educate a K-12 student yearly?** *The most recent national average indicates that \$11,762 is spent on public education per student.*
